WORD

¹Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in his ways! ²You shall eat the fruit of the labor of your hands; you shall be blessed, and it shall be well with you. ³Your wife will be like a fruitful vine within your house; your children will be like olive shoots around your table. ⁴Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the Lord.

PSALM 128:1-4

(Read also PSALM 128:5,6.)

God called parents as stewards of their family, to lead their children in the way of the Lord. But because our world is fallen, there are many challenges when it comes to living a godly life and leading a godly family. These are possible for those who fear the Lord, which stems from a knowledge and understanding of who He is. If we truly know, understand, and fear God, we will obey Him and walk in His ways. And as we seek and follow Him, His blessings will also come and overtake us (Deuteronomy 28:2). Today, we will look at how God blesses a father who fears and obeys Him.

1 God blesses the work life of a father who fears Him.

¹Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in his ways! ²You shall eat the fruit of the labor of your hands; you shall be blessed, and it shall be well with you. **PSALM 128:1,2**

The fear of the Lord will affect every area of a father's life.
It will affect his thinking and even his attitude at home and at
work. It will give him wisdom in many forms (Psalm 111:10).
He will not labor in vain because he has God at the center of
his household. He will enjoy the works of his hands because
his actions will be motivated by his desire to obey and please
God. In your own walk with God, what can you do to live a life
of obedience to Him? What does Proverbs 2:1-6 say about
how we can understand the fear of the Lord and grow in our
knowledge of Him?
